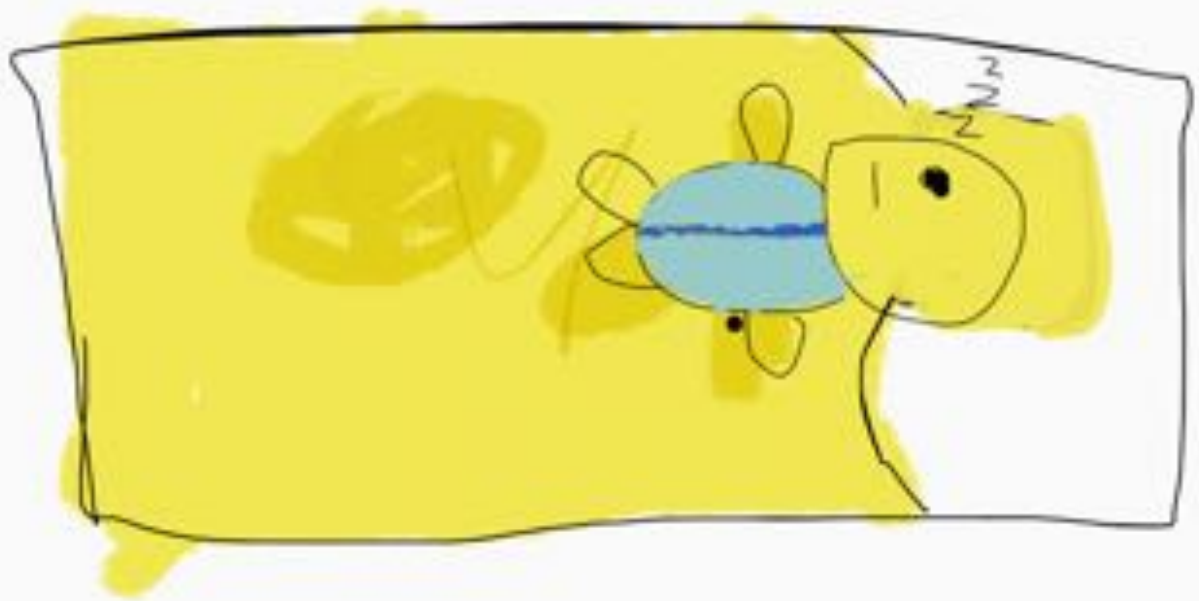

Edison

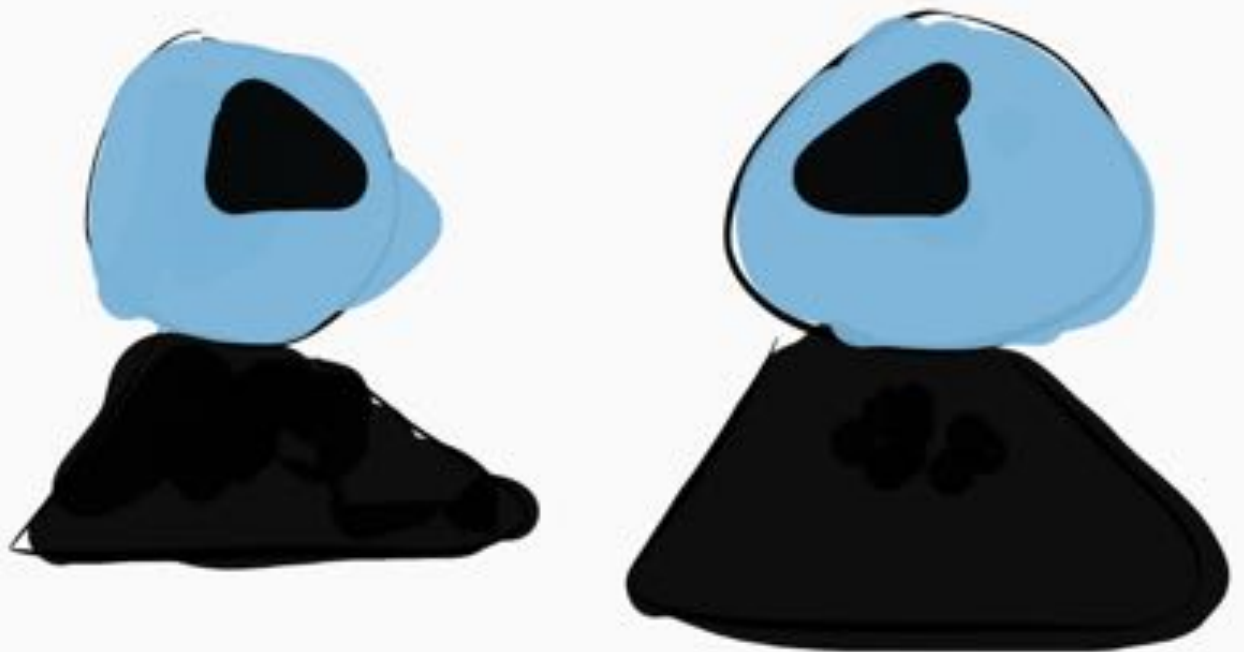

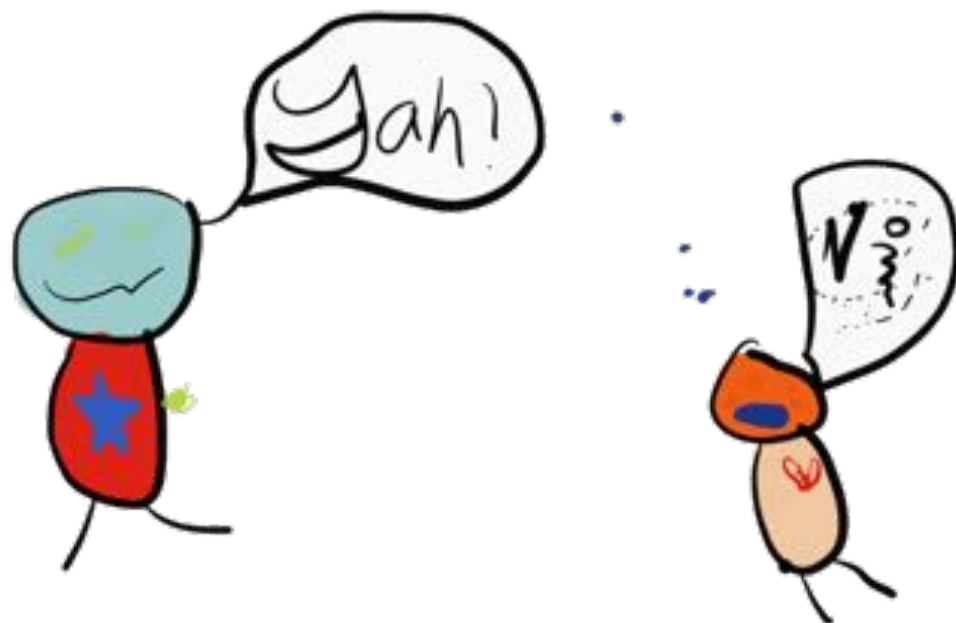

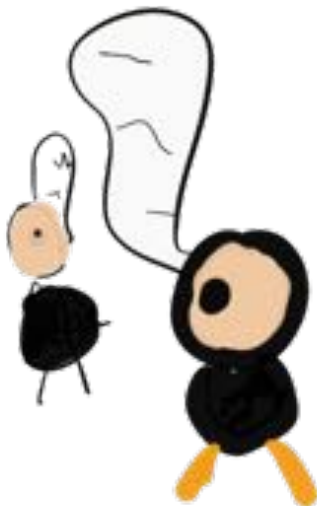
